

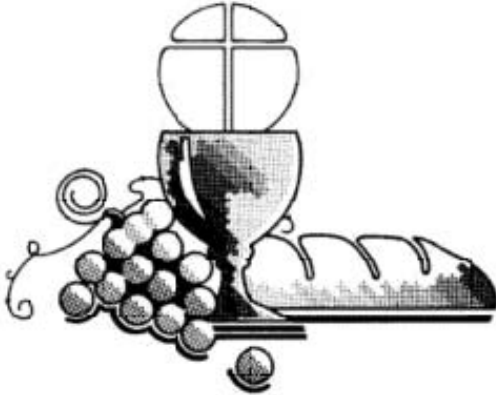

Life Chain Sunday



Dear Parishioners:

Life Chain Sunday takes place September 30 from 2-3 p.m. Life Chain is held simultaneously in more than 200 locations across Canada each year. The goal of this powerful public witness is to save lives and change hearts and minds. The protection of life from conception to natural death is a sacred and foundational tenet of our Faith.

Though it may seem like a simple task of holding a sign along a major route in Brantford, there is more to it. Those who take part are asked to give a prayerful witness through silence and presence. It's not always easy. I can recall taking part in a Life Chain event in Toronto and a few people openly challenged me for being there. One man even sarcastically asked me what the heck do I know since I do not have a uterus! I did not respond and I continued holding the sign and praying that the Lord may change hearts and minds.

Both women and men have something to say when it comes to the rights of the unborn. We all have been given the privilege and gift of life from the Author of life and loving creation, God the Father. We are not the final arbiters of our bodies. The sad but unspoken truth is that the harsh trauma of abortion not only destroys the life of the child but engenders psychological and spiritual harm for the mothers. A number of mothers who have regretted their decision have spoken openly about this time and again. They need our support and our compassion as well.

God bless those who will take part in today's event. May they courageously endure the ridicule they may encounter and may their powerful witness help change hearts and minds and save lives.
