Dear Parishioners:

If we have been following the news, we have seen the devastating fires that have recently plagued the Amazon rainforest region in Brazil. Most of the 2000 fires are man-made. Rainforests serve as lungs for the earth as they help clear our planet of pollutants and absorb carbon dioxide. Also, the amazon rainforest contain approximately 10% of the world’s biodiversity. Many species of plants can hold the key in fighting diseases.

In a month’s time the Synod of Bishops for the Pan-Amazon region is scheduled to take place. A delegation of Bishops and experts will gather in Rome to discuss new paths of evangelization of God’s people, especially indigenous peoples. 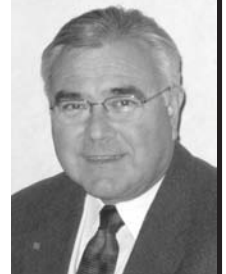
