Is. 50.4 The Lord God has given me a well-trained tongue, that I might know how to speak to the weary a word that will rouse them... Morning after morning, God opens my ear that I may hear... Isaiah suggests that our first responsibility isn't to speak, but to listen. God's gift of a "well-trained tongue" comes because "God opens my ear that I may hear." If our words are to bear fruit, they must come from the silence we observe as we listen for God's Word. Lent is a good time to train ourselves to listen better -- to God and those around us each day. Do I consider myself a good listener? What do those closest to me say about my listening skill?
