Word from the Pastor

Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever does not enter a sheepfold through the gate, but climbs over elsewhere is a thief and a robber. But whoever enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens it for him and the sheep hear his voice as the shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.

Our Shepherd Jesus isn't just a leader of a flock: we are not just part of a crowd. He "calls his own sheep by name and leads them out." It's good to know we are not lost in the crowd, or just another person in the pews, one of the anonymous sheep. There are times in our lives when we need to be reminded that Jesus knows us "by name." In biblical language, to know a person's name is to know the person. So, we are well known, and our needs are recognized by the Risen Christ in our midst. Have I experienced a personal, "by name" call from Jesus? When? Where do I feel Jesus is leading me at this point in my life? Am I responding, or resisting that call?
