Preparation for Baptism is also possible at any age. Please send a short note indicating the child's name, upcoming grade, a parent's name, and which Sacraments they hope to receive next year. We will contact all interested families for official registration in September.

<u>Synod FAQ:</u> Does Canon law permit lay people to preach? Is this happening in our diocese?

A: In a Mass, lay persons, women or men, may offer "a form of instruction designed to promote a greater understanding of the liturgy, including personal testimonies...as a means of explicating the regular homily," provided it does not assume a character which could be confused with the homily" (Ecclesiae de mysterio, article 2-3, n.2). As well, parishes can host a special Liturgy of the Word featuring a woman's reflection or offer a prayer service with a woman preaching (see Canon 766). Although this would be new to our parish, a number of other parishes in Ottawa prepared lay people to provide reflections at Mass as part of a 'Lay Reflectors Ministry'.
