Our trip to Poland for World Youth Day

The end of July this year saw with it the ending of what is called “World Youth Day”, a chance for Catholic youth from across the world to make a pilgrimage with Pope Francis. This year, millions of young people came from over 185 different countries and from six continents to meet in Krakow, Poland. I had the opportunity to attend with my sister Maire. We both live here in Stittsville.

I can tell you that these numbers were not inflated with accidental bystanders because these 1.6 to 2.5 million young people (depending on who you talked to) had to make an 8km trek from the outskirts of Krakow to a remote field. You could not drive there unless you were handicapped, a dignitary, or the Pope. Security was far too tight for those kind of risks following what has recently happened in France.

Time and again, especially on university campuses, I hear the refrain that religion is dying and that youth are no longer foolish enough, in this enlightened 21st century, to believe in medieval superstition. I can tell you that Catholicism is alive and well among the young people of the world, and that these youths lead happy, fulfilling lives— there is something truly attractive at play here.

Maybe Catholicism has not yet lost its appeal, some 2,000 years after Jesus Christ walked the earth. I recommend you give it a try— the marketplace of beliefs is crowded these days, but millions of truly satisfied customers cannot be wrong.

LIVE COVERAGE OF CANONIZATION OF MOTHER TERESA ON SALT + LIGHT TV

On September 4, 2016, the Canadian Catholic television channel Salt + Light TV will broadcast live from Saint Peter's Square, Rome, the canonization of [Blessed Mother Teresa Bojaxiu](#), founder of the Missionaries of Charity. Founded in 1950 in the Archdiocese of Calcutta, India, the congregation has today 765 houses in 138 countries, including some in Canada: Montreal, Québec, Toronto, Winnipeg, Vancouver and St. Paul (Alberta). This historic event can be watched live starting at 3:30 a.m. A few Canadian Bishops will participate in Rome at the canonization, including the Most Reverend Christian Lépine, Archbishop of Montreal, the Most Reverend Robert Harris, Bishop of Saint John, the Most Reverend Scott McCaig, C.C, Bishop of the Military Ordinariate of Canada, the Most Reverend Nicola De Angelis, Bishop Emeritus of Peterborough, and the Right Reverend Peter Novocosky, O.S.B., Abbot Ordinary Emeritus of St. Peter's at Muenster.
