From today's Gospel reading: St. Mark 1.1-8 The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ the Son of God. This is what John the Baptist proclaimed: "One mightier than I is coming after me. I am not worthy to stoop and loosen the thongs of his sandals. I have baptized you with water; he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." John the Baptist announces that the promises God made through the prophets are being fulfilled. It is, Baptist tells us, "the beginning of the Good News."
