Word from the Pastor

'[John told the people] I am baptizing you with water, for repentance, but the one who is coming after me is mightier than I.... He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.' God is making a promise to us today through John the Baptist: Someone is coming bearing a fire for spirits that are chilled by boredom, routine and cynicism. John also promises the Holy Spirit for spirits bloated with excess and in need of a renewed spirit. These are gifts we cannot buy for ourselves, but this Advent God wants to give them to those who ask for - a purifying fire and the renewing Spirit. What part of our lives needs a renewing and warming gift of divine fire? Am I praying to the Holy Spirit to come into my life this Advent?


