Did you know that the **liturgical colour** for Advent is purple, but not the same purple that we use during Lent. The purple of Advent is a bluer violet tone while Lent maintains a royal purple that is more reddish. On the third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday, the priest wears rose coloured vestments because it is a Sunday of rejoicing. We have arrived at the midpoint of Advent, our preparation is now half over and we are close to Christmas.
