#### An Examination of Conscience for Today's Catholic

(In this excerpt, the author uses both Scripture and the writings of Pope Francis to guide the Examination of Conscience.)

**Dialogue with God** *Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves and rest a while. (Mark 6.31)* 

We are overwhelmed by words, by superficial pleasures and by an increasing din, filled not by joy but rather by the discontent of those whose lives have lost meaning. How can we fail to realize the need to stop this rat race and to recover the personal space needed to carry on a heartfelt dialogue with God? Finding that space may prove painful, but it is always fruitful. (*Gaudete et Exsultate, 29*) Do I attend daily to my relationship with God? Do I withdraw regularly from life's busy-ness to enter into a heartfelt dialogue with God? How have I tried to reduce the amount of time and energy I give to "superficial pleasures"?
