JANUARY 18-25

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is celebrated around the world on January 18-25. This universal week of prayer encourages Christians of all denominations to meet, to participate in various liturgical and other community activities, and to pray together that all may be one, as Christ desires. The 2022 theme – *We saw the star in the East, and we came to worship him* (Mt 2:2) – calls Western Christians to focus on the epiphany when God's salvation is revealed to the nations in Bethlehem and at the Jordan.
