Word from the Pastor

“Called to be Saints”

At our baptism, we were given a name and welcomed into the church of believing Christians. Our identity has evolved and continues to grow and mature as God invites us to the fullness of life that is our calling, a calling to be more Christ-like and more selfless. John the Baptist physically baptized by immersing repentant persons in the Jordan River. Literally, we transliterate (not translate) the Greek word for immersion [baptizō] and we get baptize. It means the “totally immersion” of whatever or whoever is being referred to in the context. Now Jesus in much the same way floods the believer with the Holy Spirit at conversion, and then we are saturated with the Spirit of God and we are different than we were. Our identity is stamped or washed or immersed as Christian. We share in that same Spirit and, as St. Paul reminded the Corinthian Church (and all of us who are the Church), we are “sanctified in Christ Jesus” and share in His mission to keep alive the awareness of the sacred, of God’s ongoing presence and action on our world. This was an important aspect of the mission received by Jesus and a mission which he shares with all of His disciples whom he co-missions. All God asks of us, surprising as it is, is the same He asked of His own Son: to surrender ourselves to God’s will in order that God may empower us with His own Spirit and related gifts.

In today’s gospel, John speaks of two baptisms: one of water and one of the Holy Spirit. You and I are baptized in both water and the Spirit. This means that we are not only cleansed of Original Sin, but we are saturated in the life giving water — we are flooded with the Holy Spirit! When Jesus calls us into the discipleship we were created for, he also equips us with the grace to accomplish His work. For this reason, we should constantly pray for the Spirit to take possession of our hearts, and then we should prepare ourselves for the surge of power that will flow through us! You were made for discipleship, and you are only fully alive when you live out that mission.

Bishop Appointed for the Diocese of Antigonish: On December 18 His Holiness Pope Francis appointed the Most Reverend Wayne Kirkpatrick Bishop of the Diocese of Antigonish. At the time of his appointment, Bishop Kirkpatrick was serving as Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Toronto.

Pope Establishes Sunday of the Word of God: Pope Francis’ Apostolic Letter, Motu proprio “Aperuit illis”, published on 30 September, establishes that “the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination of the Word of God”.
