2 Kings reading: One day Elisha came to Shunem where there was a woman of influence, who urged him to dine with her. During the first part of our celebration today we, like the Shunemite woman welcomed God's Word into our "home" – we made room for it in our hearts. As Scripture reminds us, the Word blossoms there with a promise of new life. God sends us prophetic people to speak the Word to us, but remember, prophetic people don't always fit into official categories; they aren't always bearing an institutional stamp of approval. Yet, God often comes to us in the other and through people who are strangers. Who comes bearing the Word of God to me? Do they comfort me or challenge me with their message?
