A Word from the Pastor

The gospel of Luke records that at that time the Lord appointed seventy-two others whom he sent ahead of him in pairs to every town and place he intended to visit. The biblical number 72 represents all the nations, all the peoples of the earth. When Jesus sends out 72, it's an outreach to all people and a statement about the universality of God salvific reach. The kingdom of God, which these missionaries will announce, is for everyone -- all races and nations. No one is left out; no one is excluded. By our baptism we are all appointed as prophets. To whom is Jesus sending me? What am I to say to them?

With the approval of Archbishop Prendergast, SJ another priest will serve at Holy Spirit Parish. Fr Ben Iheagwara, CSSP is a member of the Congregation of the Holy Spirit or Spiritans and is completing a Doctorate in Philosophy at Ottawa University and will return to his native Nigeria next year. We welcome him to the community and pray for his ministry in our Parish.

The 'Spiritans' are a Roman Catholic Congregation of some three thousand members, founded in France in 1703. As a missionary congregation they are represented in over sixty countries. They are dedicated to working with the poor and in those situations where the Church has difficulty finding ministers. Together Spiritans discover Christ and His Spirit and witness the gospel way of life.

In the recent list of clergy appointments by Archbishop Prendergast, SJ some priests were designated as parochial administrators. What does this term mean? When a parish is "vacant," meaning that the pastor has retired, been transferred to another assignment, or is incapable of exercising his duties as a pastor, the bishop must appoint as soon as possible a parochial administrator. In general, an administrator has the same duties and scope of authority as a pastor; however, these may be limited by the bishop. The bishop in time may decide to appoint the administrator as the pastor. The Code of Canon Law stipulates, "For the office of pastor to be conferred on someone, it is necessary that his suitability be clearly evident by means of some method determined by the diocesan bishop, even by means of an examination" (No. 521.3). Therefore, in deciding the appointment of a pastor to a vacant parish, the bishop should make a judgment based on his knowledge of the priest's character and abilities, and on the advice of other priests and laity (No. 524). As such, the bishop may obtain this knowledge and advice during a priest's time as administrator of a parish. A bishop may transfer or remove an administrator at any time; however, a pastor does have certain rights protected by canon law and he is appointed for a term of six years in the Archdiocese of Ottawa. This appointment may be renewed by the bishop for another period of time.

WHY GO TO CHURCH?

A Church goer wrote a letter to the editor of a newspaper & complained that it made no sense to go to church every Sunday. So, I think I'm wasting my time & the preachers & priests are wasting theirs by giving sermons at all.' This started a real controversy in the 'Letters to the Editor' column. Much to the delight of the editor, it went on for weeks until someone wrote this clincher: 'I've been married for 30 years now. In that time my wife has cooked some 32,000 meals. But, for the life of me, I cannot recall the entire menu for a single one of those meals. But I do know this: They all nourished me & gave me the strength I needed to do my work. If my wife had not given me these meals, I would be physically dead today. Likewise, if I had not gone to church for nourishment, I would be spiritually dead today!'
