Word from the Pastor

From today's Gospel reading: Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in them. Just as the living Father sent me, and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. In some Christian traditions there is an "altar call," a moment when those who have heard the Word of God are invited to come forward to "accept Jesus into your life." Each time we come forward to receive the eucharistic bread and wine we are expressing our desire to take Jesus into our lives. We are responding to an "altar call" after having heard the Word. We come forward to receive the One whose life can shape our lives. In receiving his body and blood, his life, we are asking that our lives reflect, as his did, our compassionate and forgiving God. How does my receiving the Eucharist shape how I live my life? If I never again received the Eucharist, what difference would that make?

The House of Commons Bill C-314 seeks to eliminate the expansion of eligibility to those with mental illness. This is wise legislation to protect the vulnerable in our society. Let's pray it's passed into law!

<u>Synod FAO:</u> Have Church authorities spoken against women becoming deacons?

A: All Vatican statements against the ordination of women specifically address the "ministerial priesthood" and "priestly ordination," not the diaconate. In 2002, the International Theological Commission stated about women permanent deacons: "It pertains to the ministry of discernment which the Lord established in his Church to pronounce authoritatively on this question." Even as Pope Francis has confirmed that the reservation of the priesthood to men "is not a question open to discussion," he has established two papal commissions to study the question of women and the permanent diaconate. 


