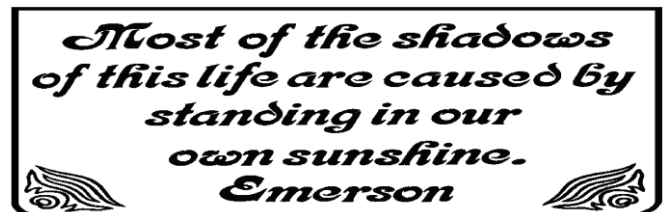

Mass in Honour of National Indigenous Peoples Day: On **Jun 21st**, Archbishop Marcel Dampousse will celebrate a Mass at St. Basil Parish, 904 Rex Ave, at 7pm in honour of National Indigenous Peoples Day. All are welcome!

Celebrating Indigenous Peoples: It is important to recognize there are three different days in the secular and faith calendar to celebrate and remember Indigenous Peoples in Canada. Jun 21st is "National Indigenous Peoples Day" in Canada. To commemorate National Indigenous Peoples' Day, we are encouraged to remember Indigenous Peoples and participate in opportunities in our local community to join in Indigenous-led initiatives and events to celebrate this day. This is a secular day and not part of the liturgical calendar, but we are encouraged to pray for the Indigenous Peoples of Canada in our daily Mass: May the Indigenous Peoples in Canada experience God's tender care and may we walk with our sisters and brothers in truth, healing and reconciliation, we pray to the Lord. Sep 30th is the "National Day for Truth and Reconciliation." The Catholic Church in Canada celebrates the "National Day of Prayer in Solidarity with Indigenous Peoples" on Dec 12th, the feast day of Our Lady of Guadalupe, patroness of the Americas.

Amalgamation Diocese of Saint-Jérôme and Diocese of Mont-Laurier: In a press release dated May 31, 2022, the Apostolic Nunciature to Canada announced that His Holiness Pope Francis has made the provision to amalgamate the Diocese of Saint-Jérôme and the Diocese of Mont-Laurier, currently united in the person of the Bishop into one ecclesiastical circumscription and to create the Diocese of St-Jérôme-Mont-Laurier. The Most Reverend Raymond Poisson is appointed as Bishop of the new Diocese of St-Jérôme-Mont-Laurier.
