# <u>Synod FAQ:</u> Women are already doing the work of deacons. Why do we need to ordain them?

A: Local bishops could invite, train and ordain women who feel called to this ministry. These women would then be able to receive the grace of the Sacrament of Holy Orders as deacons, and be officially recognized by the Church, just as men permanent deacons are formed and serve today. Particularly in rural and marginalized communities, there is a need for more labourers in the vineyard. Women deacons, like men deacons, could preach at Liturgies of the Word with pre-consecrated Communion, celebrate baptisms, witness weddings, officiate at funeral services and accompany those in need of pastoral presence. 


