### HOW TO KNOW JESUS' TEACHING ON EUTHANASIA AND ASSISTED SUICIDE - Archbishop Terrence Prendergast, S.J.

In the Gospel of Matthew Jesus tells his followers how to behave: "in everything do to others as you would have them do to you; for this is the law and the prophets" (Matthew 7:12).

Later Jesus warns his disciples that they and we will be judged by how we have treated those most in need of mercy and help: "truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me: (Matthew 25:40).

Euthanasia and assisted suicide are acts of desperation that reject the value of human life and regard all suffering as an affront to human dignity. Catholic Christians, however, see great dignity in the last days of life lived as comfortable as possible sharing with family and friends a final witness to life's value.

As members of a democracy, Christians have the right and duty to share their views on issues affecting themselves and fellow Canadians. We also need to inform ourselves about the church's teaching founded on the message of Jesus Christ on these issues so that we can act in accord with our faith and present reasoned arguments to those who disagree with our position.

The right to life and security of the person is fundamental to a just and caring society. As Catholic Christians we must listen to Christ's clear message expressed through the Church that a true disciple is someone who treasures the dignity of human life and who seeks to help, not harm others.

## *A Word from the Pastor*

From today's Galatians reading of St. Paul: "God, who from my mother's womb has set me apart and called me through his grace, was pleased to reveal his Son to me..." Paul is very conscious that the good he has received from God was pure gift. Through our Baptism the Christian community has also received the gift of Jesus Christ. Paul reminds us that, as recipients of such a wonderful gift, we too must proclaim Christ to others. How do we proclaim Christ to others in our daily lives? Have we been reluctant or felt intimidated to speak and act on Christ's behalf?

Father Tavis Goski was ordained to the Priesthood by Archbishop Prendergast on June 3 at Notre Dame Cathedral. He will serve in the Archdiocese of Ottawa.

The new Sacred Heart Mausoleum at Hope Cemetery was solemnly blessed by Archbishop Prendergast in May. There are now 626 additional glass front niches and 80 additional crypts as well as a large new multi-functional hall where families can gather for a funeral or a reception. 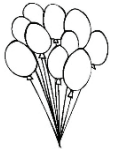
### **AN INTERFAITH MUSICAL EVENT - Sun., June 12 - 3:00 p.m**
