Many people spread their cloaks on the road, and others spread leafy branches. Those preceding Jesus as well as those following kept crying out, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord." Despite the fact that Jesus' appearances were humble, this did not turn people off or drive them away from him. We tend to be impressed by splash and displays of power that fill us with awe. Jesus doesn't draw attention by such grandiose spectacles, but because his words and actions hold out hope to the weary and hopeless. Today we join the crowds who greet Jesus as he enters Jerusalem and add our own "Hosannas" to theirs. What is there about Jesus that draws me to him and keeps me as his follower? What can I do to reflect his simplicity and humility in my daily actions?

An Examination of Conscience for Today's Catholic

(In this excerpt, the author uses both Scripture and the writings of Pope Francis to guide the Examination of Conscience.)

Intercessory prayer Ask, and it will be given you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened for you. For everyone who asks receives, and everyone who searches finds, and for everyone who knocks, the door will be opened. (Luke 11.9-10) Let us not downplay prayer of petition, which so often calms our hearts and helps us persevere in hope. Prayer of intercession has particular value, for it is an act of trust in God and, at the same time, an expression of love for our neighbour. (Gaudete et Exsultate, 154) Do I pray with perseverance for the needs of others to be met? Do I trust that God will answer those prayers, sometimes in ways beyond my understanding? Do I see my own personal prayer as contributing to the life of society and the Christian community?
