The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a faith formation program for children where the treasures of the Catholic faith found in scripture and liturgy are shared. Synod Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ): Isn't the Synod over?

A: NO! Pope Francis extended the global Synod to October 2024, challenging us to "Enlarge the Space of your tent". Many issues emerged like the needs of divorced, LGBTQ and young Catholics. Also "A critical and urgent area...concerns the role of women and their vocation, rooted in our common baptismal dignity, to participate fully in the life of the Church." (www.synod.va: Document for the Continental Stage). We are encouraged to be increasingly Synodal, discerning, praying and walking together. A Synod FAQ on restoring the ordination of Catholic women as deacons, will be posted weekly in our bulletin. Parish events are being planned. Join Team Holy Spirit!
