Word from the Pastor

From today's Book of Revelation 21.10: The angel took me in spirit to a great, high mountain and showed me the holy city Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God. Revelation keeps our feet firmly rooted in our present struggles to live the Christian life; but it also focuses our eyes on what is to come. The world's indomitable powers, despite present appearances, will be overcome. In the meanwhile, John is inviting us to turn away from the false values and powers of the world and focus on the vision of the new Holy City where we will dwell with God and one another. How does our hope in a permanent future with God affect our lives now? What signs do I see that strengthen my hope in the power of good over evil?

The Vatican confirmed on May 13th that Pope Francis will visit three cities in Canada during the last week of July. The pope will travel to Edmonton, Quebec City, and Iqaluit on July 24-30, the Holy See press office said on May 13. The pope had announced last month that he planned to meet indigenous peoples in Canada this summer for the feast of St. Anne on July 26th. "You have brought the living sense of your communities here in Rome. I will be happy to benefit again from meeting you by visiting your native lands, where your families live," he said during a meeting with Canadian Indigenous leaders at the Vatican on April 1st.

Last weekend we bid farewell to Joanne Parenteau and wish her God's favour and peace in her ministry as organist and Choir Director at another Parish. We thank her for her devotion to the people of our Parish!
