#### Synod Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ):

# Have there ever been women deacons in the Catholic Church?

A: Yes, absolutely. Women deacons are an ancient tradition in the Roman Catholic Church. Saint Phoebe, during the time of Saint Paul in the early years of Christianity, was identified as a "deacon of the Church at Cenchrea" (Romans 16: 1-2). The Council of Chalcedon (451) recognized the ordination of women permanent deacons and required them to be 40 and celibate. Women deacons were ordained by bishops in the sanctuary with an epiclesis (the calling down of the Holy Spirit) and the laying on of hands. 
