## A Word from the Pastor

Jesus said to the disciples: The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you. Jesus and the Father come to dwell in those who keep Jesus' word. The Father sends the Spirit who stirs up the mission of Jesus and sends us to do as he did: preach and heal in his name. The Spirit nurtures love in us and, through the wisdom the Spirit gives, we learn concrete ways to show that love. What gifts have we received from the Spirit that we can put to the service of Jesus? Are there gifts we need from the Spirit this coming Pentecost to enable us to live Jesus' life more faithfully in the world?

Please note that when taking the Eucharist home to the sick the protocol to follow is to mention the request to me before the celebration begins if possible. You will need a pyx to offer Communion. The Eucharist will be consecrated at the celebration. Please approach the altar when all the people have received and Holy Communion will be given to you. It is to be taken immediately to the sick person. Do not remain in the Church but go to offer the Sacrament to the person. As you offer them the Eucharist please say: the Body of Christ and they respond Amen.


