POPE INSTITUTES FEAST OF OUR LADY, MOTHER OF CHURCH

The liturgical memorial of the **Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church** - currently celebrated in Poland and Argentina - has been extended to the universal Church and will be celebrated on the day after Pentecost Sunday, this year on **Monday, May 21**. Cardinal Robert Sarah, prefect of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, said that the new feast emphasizes "the importance of the mystery of Mary's spiritual motherhood, which from the awaiting of the Spirit at Pentecost has never ceased to take motherly care of the pilgrim Church on earth."

Word from the Pastor

Solemnity of Pentecost: And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. It is clear that the Spirit does not leave the disciples comfortable, safe, locked away in a sheltered world. When the Spirit comes those who were huddled together are driven out into the world -- a very different and confused world than they were accustomed to. But they were not on their own. They were sent and accompanied by the Spirit. The Holy Spirit is sometimes called, "The Forgotten God." How conscious am I of the Spirit in prayer and worship? In my daily undertakings?
