Word from the Pastor

Women's Rights: Pope Francis addressed the fight for women's equality during a press conference aboard the papal plane to Rome on Sunday. Speaking in-flight from Bahrain to Italy Nov 6, the pope said women are a gift to society — but the struggle for their fundamental rights is doomed to continue as long as there are places in the world where women are not valued as equals. Returning from the Muslim-majority country of Bahrain, Pope Francis was asked if he supports the efforts of women and young people in Iran to fight for more freedom. "We have to tell the truth," the pope said, "The fight for women's rights is an ongoing fight because in some places women have equality with men but in other places they do not."
