Advent means 'coming,' and during the season, we prepare for Jesus' coming. The four Sundays of Advent, which precede Christmas, are recognized for four virtues. The candles on the Advent wreath symbolize hope, love, joy and peace. The candles are lit in that order reflecting Christ's light coming through the darkness. The three purple candles represent the preparation and repentance during the season of Advent. The pink candle is lit on the third Sunday of Advent, called Gaudete Sunday, meaning 'rejoice.' The rose color symbolizes the period of waiting is almost over.
