PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS: First Sunday of Advent – Nov 27.
That we all may be attentive in listening for God's call, and especially that those who God has called to the priesthood or consecrated religious life will hear Him and answer.

Today brings the Jubilee Year of Mercy to a close. It is fitting, I believe, to ask the question: *Did we, the church, accomplish what we set out to do for this year of mercy?* To answer this let us reflect upon the words of Pope Francis who, at a papal audience on December 9, 2015 addressed the question: *Why have a Jubilee of Mercy? What does this mean?* Here is some of what he said. *"The Jubilee is a favourable time for all of us, because by contemplating Divine Mercy, which overcomes all human limitations and shines in the darkness of sin, we are able to become more certain and effective witnesses. Turning our gaze to God, merciful Father, and to our brothers and sisters in need of mercy, means focusing our attention on the essential contents of the Gospel: Jesus, Mercy made flesh, who renders the great mystery of the Trinitarian Love of God visible to our eyes ... placing Jesus Christ, the merciful God, at the centre of our personal life and that of our communities. It is a Holy Year, therefore, so as to live mercy. ... It is a privileged moment for the Church to learn to choose only what pleases God most. What is it that pleases God most? Forgiving his children, having mercy on them, so that they in turn forgive their brothers and sisters, shining as a flame of God's mercy in the world."* So, how did we do?

Word from the Pastor

In St. Luke's account Jesus replied to the criminal hanging beside him, "Amen I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise." Perhaps, like the "good thief," we currently look out at the world from our own cross. Can we put faith in the words Jesus speaks to us now, even in the midst of defeat, disappointment or broken dreams? They aren't mere words, because Christ's words bring us his promise that even now ("today") we too are assured new life. Can we trust his words? Even from the weakness of the cross Jesus used his power to give life. What powers do I have? Do I use them as Christ did to serve, comfort, heal and bring life to others?

Due to pressing needs in the Archdiocese of Ottawa, Archbishop Prendergast has appointed Fr. Ben to be administrator of St. Jude Parish, Hawkesbury and Our Lady of Divine Love in Pendleton. We wish him God's blessing in his new assignment.
