

While the Church and Indigenous peoples have been on a journey towards mutuality and healing for several years, last year's visit by Pope Francis brought a certain urgency for reconciliation, for healing and for justice. Your generous participation in "A Christ-Centred, Co-Journey Towards Healing" is a concrete step on this journey. This week's Synod update:

The 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops and Laity, finished their third week of discernment where their focus was on the question: "Co-responsible for the mission": "How to share tasks and gifts in the service of the Gospel?" They discerned the question of women's greater participation, including the possibility of restoring women to the permanent diaconate. As one of 10 delegated Presidents for Pope Francis, Sister María de los Dolores Palencia Gómez, Superior General of the Congregation of St. Joseph of Lyon, was the first woman ever to preside over a Synod of Bishops at these discernments. She described the experience of sitting with Pope Francis at the head table as "a gift and a grace" — and a sign of things to come in the Catholic Church. Please keep praying for our 11 Canadians and the other participants that they will listen and hear the voice of Christ as they discern. Salt and Light has a weekly TV summary each Saturday evening.
