

Word from the Pastor

St. Matthew 21. "Finally, the owner of the vineyard sent his son to the tenants of the vineyard, thinking, 'They will respect my son.' But when the tenants saw the son, they said to one another, 'This is the heir. Come let us kill him and acquire his inheritance.' They seized him, threw him out of the vineyard and killed him." We need the middle section of today's gospel story - the part about the additional servants and the owner's son being sent to the rebellious tenants of the vineyard. Jesus is telling us something about God that we need to hear. God doesn't give up on us, even when we have turned away from God. God is even willing to risk looking foolish in our eyes, willing to come again and again to us. God's love doesn't diminish, even when we reject God or live lukewarm lives of faith. Is there someone in my life who has been a persistent voice urging me to change? Is it possible in that person's persistence, God is urging me to make some necessary changes and God is using that person to reach out to me?

The Synod on Synodality began in Rome from October 4-29. Pope Francis has invited members of the universal Church to participate to listen to God's word, to pray and reflect on the present realities of the Church and the world to which we are sent to bear witness to the Risen Lord.

The Diocesan Retreat with retired Toronto Cardinal Thomas Collins will be held at Pinestone Resort, in Haliburton October 10-13. Mass on Mon Oct 9. No masses Tuesday to Friday.

This week's Synod update: The 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops began this Wednesday! It ends Oct 29. Our Canadian delegates were at the ecumenical prayer Vigil for for the Synod last Saturday in Rome. It was beautiful! If you missed it, see vatican.va and click on this event. They also walked through a retreat, all together, where Silence was the theme. Pope Francis reminds all of our need to listen to Christ in Silence, to ponder. Let's keep praying with our 11 Canadians and the other over 400 participants that they will listen and hear the voice of Christ as they discern big questions in our church today.
