Word from the Pastor

From Paul's Second Letter to Timothy: "All Scripture is inspired by God, and is useful for teaching, for refutation, for correction and for training in righteousness." Paul is writing to Timothy who has responsibility for leadership in the church. For many of us such leadership takes the shape of preaching, administration, liturgical functions, ministry to the sick, dying, poor, imprisoned etc. Paul advises Timothy to grow in faith and remain faithful to what he has learned and believed. He advises that growth has its roots in the Scriptures. What is applicable to Timothy's faith is applicable to our own. What part do the Scriptures play in my spiritual life? What can I do to grow in my knowledge and love of the Scriptures?
