Word from the Pastor

St. Paul writes to Timothy, "The Lord will rescue me from every evil threat and will bring me safe to his heavenly kingdom. To him be glory forever and ever. Amen." Paul's trust in God isn't based on his own merits, but on the Lord who, "will rescue me from every evil threat and will bring me safe to his heavenly kingdom." Like the tax collector in today's Gospel, Paul is not the subject of the sentence, he is the object, that is, the recipient of Christ's graciousness. Do I subtly take credit for my good works, or do I see God as their source? What are my gifts to offer in God's service? Do I acknowledge and thank God for them.

Today is World Mission Sunday, allowing us to celebrate missionary activity and also deepen our understanding of the spiritual meaning of mercy. We assist people in prayer and financial ways in remote villages, towns and cities through the witness and work of missionaries and local priests.
