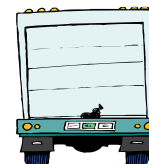

FOOTPRINTS IN THE SAND

What will change?

Since this is a new translation of the whole Mass, almost every prayer has changed, from the responses of the people to the prayers of the priest, especially, the central prayer of the Mass, the Eucharistic Prayer. Other changes will be the prayers we sing together, such as the "Glory to God," the "Holy, Holy, Holy," the Memorial Acclamation, and the dialogues between priest and people. Since there are new translations, there will be new musical compositions that choirs, song leaders and instrumentalists will have to learn. One acclamation that will be lost is the "Christ has died". While this has been the most popular of the Memorial Acclamations, it was not in the original Latin Text. It was a text exclusive to English. While stronger acclamations in English are in the third person, the Latin acclamations are in the second person, addressed to Christ. For this reason the Vatican (Congregation for Divine Worship) decided to exclude it from the English.

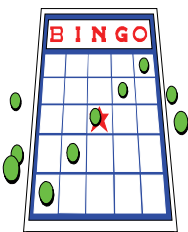
