

Fasting, which is to be done in a generous spirit, can vary from person to person depending upon health and other factors, some taking only bread and water, some adopting a vegetarian diet, some taking only one complete meal. Fasting is for Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must <u>abstain from meat or some other</u> favourite food and use moderation in all food and drink, on Good Friday.

<u>Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament</u> Due to the Holy Thursday celebration, there will be no Thursday afternoon Adoration this week. Instead, ADORATION WILL FOLLOW THE 7:00 PM MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER on Holy Thursday and will continue to 11:00 pm.

## Archdiocesan Celebration of the Chrism Mass and Thanksgiving for Archbishop's O'Brien's Ministry in the Archdiocese


