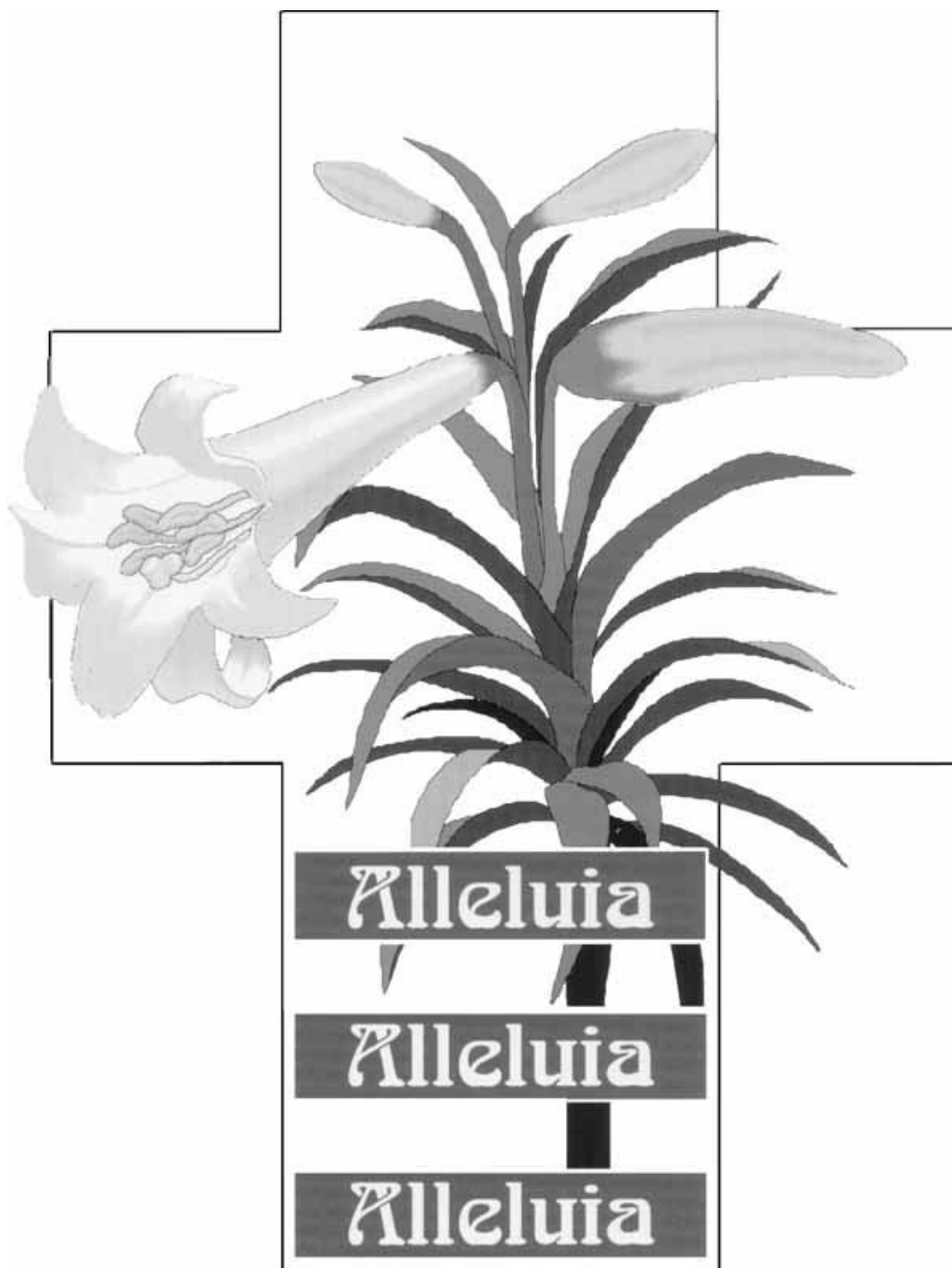

**The Divine Mercy Novena begins Good Friday**

Jesus asked that the Feast of Divine Mercy (this year April 28<sup>th</sup>) be preceded by a Novena to the Divine Mercy which would begin on Good Friday (this year April 19<sup>th</sup>). The different souls prayed for on each day on the novena are:

- Day 1 (Good Friday) – All mankind, especially sinners
- Day 2 (Holy Saturday) – The souls of priests and religious
- Day 3 (Easter Sunday) – All devout and faithful souls
- Day 4 (Easter Monday) – Those who do not believe in Jesus and those who do not yet know Him
- Day 5 (Easter Tuesday) – The souls of separated brethren
- Day 6 (Easter Wednesday) – The meek and humble souls and the souls of children
- Day 7 (Easter Thursday) – The souls who especially venerate and glorify Jesus’ mercy
- Day 8 (Easter Friday) – The souls who are detained in purgatory
- Day 9 (Easter Saturday) – The souls who have become lukewarm
