Ash Wednesday is next Wednesday, February 14th. Ashes will be distributed at the **9:00 am and 7:00 pm masses**. **The Way of the Cross** will be held each Friday evening in Lent beginning next Friday, February 16th at 5:15 pm.

We are obliged to join the Church around the world in fast and abstinence on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday. Fasting, which is to be done in a generous spirit, can vary from person to person depending upon health and other factors, some taking only bread and water, some adopting a vegetarian diet, some taking only one complete meal. Fasting is for Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat or some other favourite food and use moderation in all food and drink, on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Every Friday throughout the rest of the year is a day of abstinence for Catholics who are 14 years or older; we may substitute acts of charity or piety for abstinence from meat on those days.
