

#### KINGSTON STAY AT HOME ORDER LIFTED

Premier Ford has lifted the Stay at Home order for our region and returned us to the 'Green' designation. Starting February 13/14 we at Holy Family are back to our pre-lockdown mass schedule with 80 people allowed at each mass (30% of capacity). This means:

- 1. Physical distancing will be required for all. Families may sit in their own bubbles.
- 2. You will not be required to register before you come. Just come.
- 3. Your name & phone number will be taken at the entrance.
- 4. You must wear a mask in the church at all times.
- 5. You will sanitize your hands and be ushered to a seat. Please wait for someone to seat you.
- 6. Weekday masses are back to the pre-shutdown schedule (see above).
- 7. Confessions will be heard on Saturdays from 4:30 to 5:00 pm or by appointment (please call the office to schedule)

<u>Ash Wednesday</u>, the start of Lent, is February 17<sup>th</sup>. There will be two masses on that day, at **9:00 am** and **7:00 pm**. The 9:00 am will not be attended by the school children. There will be an Ash Wednesday collection for the <u>St. Vincent de Paul Society of Kingston</u>. We are asked to provide our own envelope, adding name, address and envelope number. Please make cheques payable to Holy Family Parish.

Eucharistic Adoration will resume during Lent on Thursdays from 1:00 to 5:00 pm.

Stations of the Cross will be held on the Fridays of Lent starting at 5:15 pm.

The <u>dispensation from the obligation</u> for Sundays and Holy Days remains in place.

We are obliged to join the Church around the world in <u>fast and abstinence on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday</u>. Fasting, which is to be done in a generous spirit, can vary from person to person depending upon health and other factors, some taking only bread and water, some adopting a vegetarian diet, some taking only one complete meal. Fasting is for Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must <u>abstain from meat or some other favourite food</u> and use moderation in all food and drink, on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Every Friday throughout the rest of the year is a day of abstinence for Catholics who are 14 years or older; we may substitute acts of charity or piety for abstinence from meat on those days.


