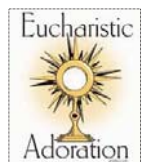


### BACK TO OUR REGULAR SCHEDULE!

We at Holy Family are back to our regular mass schedule with 80 people allowed at each mass (30% of capacity). This means:

1. Physical distancing is required for all. Families may sit in their own bubbles.
2. You are not required to register before you come. Just come.
3. Your name & phone number will be taken at the entrance.
4. You must wear a mask in the church at all times.
5. You will sanitize your hands and be ushered to a seat. Please wait for someone to seat you.
6. Weekday masses are back to the regular schedule (see above).
7. Confessions are heard on Saturdays from 4:30 to 5:00 pm or by appointment (please call the office to schedule)

Eucharistic Adoration takes place on Thursdays from 1:00 to 5:00 pm. Adorers sanitize their seat before they leave.



Stations of the Cross are held on the Fridays of Lent starting at 5:15 pm. Everyone sanitizes their seat before they leave.

The dispensation from the obligation for Sundays and Holy Days remains in place.
