

<u>Ash Wednesday</u> is this Wednesday, February 26th. Ashes will be distributed at the **9:00 am and 7:00 pm masses**. <u>The Way of the Cross</u> will be held each Friday evening in Lent beginning this Friday, February 28th at 5:15 pm.



We are obliged to join the Church around the world in <u>fast and abstinence on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday</u>. Fasting, which is to be done in a generous spirit, can vary from person to person depending upon health and other factors, some taking only bread and water, some adopting a vegetarian diet, some taking only one complete meal. Fasting is for Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must <u>abstain from meat or some other favourite</u> food and use moderation in all food and drink, on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Every Friday throughout the rest of the year is a day of abstinence for Catholics who are 14 years or older; we may substitute acts of charity or piety for abstinence from meat on those days.

Lent is a special time of prayer, penance, sacrifice and good works in preparation of the celebration of Easter. During the 40 days of Lent, perhaps we could consider doing some or all of the following: attend a week day mass, receive the sacrament of reconciliation, spend a holy hour with the Blessed Sacrament, pray a Rosary, Bible reading, participate in the Stations of the Cross, visit someone in a nursing home or hospital, make a donation of personal care items to a shelter or St. Vincent de Paul, donate food or money to the Food Bank or St. Vincent de Paul, volunteer your time, fast (give up one meal, if you are able to do so), let someone in front of you in line at a store or bank, speak to a homeless person, make a donation to a local charity, smile or say hello to a stranger, send a cheerful note to a friend or neighbour, thank someone for a kindness, hug your family
