Ash Wednesday is next Wednesday, March 1st. Ashes will be distributed at the 9:00 am and 7:00 pm masses. **The Way of the Cross** will be held each Friday evening in Lent beginning next Friday, March 3rd at 5:15 pm.

We are obliged to join the Church around the world in fast and abstinence on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday. Fasting means only one full meal for Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Every Friday throughout the rest of the year is a day of abstinence from meat for Catholics who are 14 years or older; we may substitute acts of charity or piety for abstinence from meat on those days.
