FIRST WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS & THE ELDERLY (SUNDAY, JULY 25, 2021)

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops has produced **a short video message for this day**, bringing to life the theme chosen for this day, *"I am with you always"* (cf. Mt 28:20). The video message encourages young people, families, and communities to draw near and to spend time with grandparents and the elderly, cherishing their essential role for the Church and society.
