### FIRST WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS & THE ELDERLY (SUNDAY, JULY 25, 2021)

Pope Francis has called for a day to honour grandparents and the elderly **this Sunday, July 25<sup>th</sup>**. We are encouraged to celebrate our grandparents or elderly neighbours / friends in our life. The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops has produced a **short video message for this day**, bringing to life the theme chosen for this day, *“I am with you always”* (cf. Mt 28:20). The video message encourages young people, families, and communities to draw near and to spend time with grandparents and the elderly, cherishing their essential role for the Church and society.

Pope Francis quotes Benedict XVI when speaking of **prayer as a specific mission of the elderly**: *“the prayer of the elderly can protect the world and help it perhaps more incisively than the toil of so many. Your prayer is a most precious resource: it is a lung of which the Church and the world cannot be deprived (cf. Apostolic Exhortation Evangelii Gaudium, 262).*
