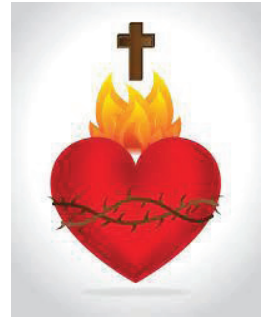

### **Excerpts from *Heart Speaks to Heart – A Pastoral Letter on the Sacred Heart of Jesus*, by Cardinal Thomas Collins, Archbishop of Toronto**

For Catholic Christians, as May is the Month of Mary, so June is the Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Individuals, families, parishes and Catholic schools are strongly encouraged to specially dedicate the month of June to the Sacred Heart.

For a Christian the love signified by the Sacred Heart is not a passing emotion, but the steady, reliable, faithful, life-giving love which we experience in Jesus as we encounter him in the Gospels, in the Sacraments, and in our life of faith. We are called to imitate that faithful love.

The Sacred Heart is **surrounded by flames**. These are flames of glory, for love of the quality represented by the love of Jesus is truly glorious. They are flames that provide light in a world darkened by sin, and warmth in a world that too often is cold, that treats people as things to be used, not as persons to be loved.

We can grow in holiness by weaving through our day the constant repetition of the short prayer: “*O Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in you.*”

## RE-OPENING ONTARIO STEP 1

Further to announcements from the provincial government and Archbishop Mulhall's office, on June 11, 2021 our province moved to Step One of the gradual re-opening of Ontario. Under Step One, churches are permitted to have 15% of their seating capacity for Masses and other forms of worship.

At Holy Family this will mean a maximum of 50 people in attendance at our masses. **Names and phone numbers will be recorded for all in attendance to permit contact tracing**. We are also required to wear face masks and practice social distancing.

Commencing Sunday June 20<sup>th</sup> and continuing until further notice, we ask that people pre-register for the 9:30 am Sunday Mass by contacting Kathryn Nickerson 613 544 5457 (leave a message) or [p.k.nickerson@sympatico.ca](mailto:p.k.nickerson@sympatico.ca) , as we are often near capacity for that Mass. Kathryn will confirm whether a seat is still available at that mass. Other weekend and weekday Masses do not require pre-registration.
