

**St. Francis of Assisi Catholic School** has been declared the name of the new Algonquin and Lakeshore Catholic District School Board elementary school. The Board of Trustees voted by ballot at the June 21 board meeting. As directed by the Board, the school naming committee brought forward recommendations for a new school name following community consultation and committee deliberation. This was done through a survey that was open May 2<sup>nd</sup> to May 27<sup>th</sup>. The survey gathered 68 responses with 41 unique names.

"St. Francis of Assisi is an excellent choice for the name of this new Catholic school. St. Francis represents strong faith, charity and care of the environment," said Greg Speagle, Chair of the Board. "This speaks to Stewardship and Discipleship, which are integral pillars of the Board Strategic Plan and Board Improvement Plan."

St. Francis of Assisi Catholic School will consolidate Holy Family Catholic School, St. Peter Catholic School and St. Patrick Catholic School. It is being constructed to accommodate 363 students and will consist of 15 learning studios, three learning commons, one media common, a gymnasium and other administrative spaces. It is currently anticipated that the project will be completed for the start of the 2017-2018 school year in September 2017.
