

## Excerpts from *Heart Speaks to Heart – A Pastoral Letter on the Sacred Heart of Jesus*, by Cardinal Thomas Collins, Archbishop of Toronto

In face of the difficulties of our age, we listen even more intently to Our Lord:

"Come to me, all you who labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." (Matthew 11:28-29)

For Catholic Christians, as May is the Month of Mary, so June is the Month of the Sacred Heart. Individuals, families, parishes and Catholic schools are strongly encouraged to specially dedicate the month of June to the Sacred Heart.

- Make a Holy Hour of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament
- Read a portion of one of the Gospels every day
- Participate in Mass at any time, and perhaps on consecutive First Fridays
- Place an image of the Sacred Heart in your home, and consecrate your family to the Sacred Heart.

  As has been said, the family that prays together stays together.
- Give prominence to an image of the Sacred Heart in your parish Church
- Personally, carry an image of the Sacred Heart




