We are obliged to join the Church around the world in fast and abstinence on Good Friday. Fasting, which is to be done in a generous spirit, can vary from person to person depending upon health and other factors, some taking only bread and water, some adopting a vegetarian diet, some taking only one complete meal. Fasting is for Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat or some other favourite food and use moderation in all food and drink, on Good Friday.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament Due to the Holy Thursday celebration, there will be no Thursday afternoon Adoration this week. Instead, ADORATION WILL FOLLOW THE 7:00 PM MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER on Holy Thursday and will continue to 11:00 pm.
