A "Call for Conscience" campaign has been initiated **to encourage Ontarians to write to their local MPP's asking them to protect conscience rights** – in particular, to support an amendment to Bill 84 that would provide conscience protection for doctors and health care providers and create a care coordination service which protects both patients and health care workers. 
