Registration will take place Tuesday-Friday, 11am – 4pm, by calling 613-542-8587 or emailing <u>holyfamilychurch@cogeco.ca</u>, starting immediately. ALL SEATS FOR THESE 2 LITURGIES MUST BE BOOKED IN ADVANCE BY NOON ON 1 APRIL. The other Holy Week liturgies do not require registration.

We are obliged to join the Church around the world in <u>fast and abstinence on Good Friday</u>. Fasting, which is to be done in a generous spirit, can vary from person to person depending upon health and other factors, some taking only bread and water, some adopting a vegetarian diet, some taking only one complete meal. Fasting is for Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must <u>abstain from meat or some other favourite food</u> and use moderation in all food and drink, on Good Friday.
