

<u>Ash Wednesday</u> is next Wednesday, March 6th. Ashes will be distributed at the **9:00 am and 7:00 pm masses**. <u>The Way of the Cross</u> will be held each Friday evening in Lent beginning next Friday, March 8th at 5:15 pm.

We are obliged to join the Church around the world in <u>fast and abstinence on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday</u>. Fasting, which is to be done in a generous spirit, can vary from person to person depending upon health and other factors, some taking only bread and water, some adopting a vegetarian diet, some taking only one complete meal. Fasting is for Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. In addition, all Catholics 14 years of age and older must <u>abstain from meat or some other favourite food</u> and use moderation in all food and drink, on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Every Friday throughout the rest of the year is a day of abstinence for Catholics who are 14 years or older; we may substitute acts of charity or piety for abstinence from meat on those days.

<u>Our Monthly Seniors Mass</u> will be celebrated at **11:00** am on Tuesday, March 5th followed by lunch at the Swiss Chalet, 85 Dalton Ave. Please join us for this celebration of faith and fellowship. Transportation is available.


IRISH DINNER
