VIRTUE OF THE MONTH – APRIL During the month of April, Sudbury Catholic Schools are celebrating the value of **STEWARDSHIP**. We will be relating the topic of stewardship to our work and responsibility as keepers of the beautiful world God has given us. Please pray for our Catholic School staff and students as they continue to put virtues into action.

1. TOGETHER IN FAITH – OCSTA - The **Ontario Catholic School Trustees' Association (OCSTA)** provides the provincial voice for elected Catholic school trustees to promote and protect publicly funded Catholic education. We are distinctly together in faith. Our Catholic education system is designed to offer an inclusive learning environment, fostering spirituality to produce top academic and community-minded graduates. Our educational mission is the transmission of knowledge and the formation of the whole person: body, mind and spirit.

2. Catholic School Support - Do you know if you are listed as a Catholic School supporter? Municipal elections are important to the future of **Catholic Education and to Catholic families** whose ongoing support is instrumental in the preservation and enhancement of the system.

In order to vote for a **Sudbury Catholic District School Board Trustees**, you must be registered as an English-Separate supporter. All Roman Catholics, whether they are registered homeowners or tenants, with or without children, are entitled to support Catholic education. If support is not directed to the English Separate system, you are automatically considered a public-school supporter. Please ensure you are registered as an English-Separate supporter on the Voter Registry.

Your support of Catholic education is vitally important for many reasons:

- It is the basis of attendance rights for admission into Sudbury Catholic elementary schools;
- It is a public record of the extent of support for our Sudbury Catholic schools, providing the government with an indication of the overall support and strength of a publicly funded Catholic school system.
- It is used to determine the number of trustees to be elected to each board to represent the interests of parents and other ratepayers;

How can I find out which way my support is directed?

- Visit www.voterlookup.ca and follow the instructions to check your support.
- Check your tax bill or assessment form to see how your support has been designated.
- If you do not have these forms, you may also contact the City Clerk for your municipality to inquire how to check the local list of electors. The Clerk's Office will provide you with information as to how to be added to the list or to change your support.

3. Support Catholic Education - Catholic education has been an integral part of Ontario's history for more than 160 years. As a vital component of the province's publicly funded education system, Catholic schools educate nearly 600,000 students each year. Your school support defaults to English Public each time you move residences. You must re-declare yourself as English Separate. It is important to regularly verify your tax-directed support by checking your property tax bill or speaking to your landlord. You may also call the Municipal Property Assessment Office at 1-866-296-6722 to complete school support changes for electoral purposes or to add a name(s) to an existing address.
