Discovering Christ Winter 2020

Discovering Christ is a program for those who wish to hear the Good News and personally encounter Jesus Christ. The focus is on making Christ more visible in the life of Christians in our parish and beyond. There are seven Thursday evening sessions, plus a Saturday retreat day. All sessions and the retreat will be at St. Patrick's Church. Each session includes 4 components: shared light meal, welcome and prayer, video presentation and small group discussion. The meal consists of soup, beverages and dessert. You are welcome to bring a 'brown-bag'. Menus will be provided in advance. We will begin the evening at 6:00 pm. The evening will conclude at 8:30 pm. The retreat day (light meal & snacks included) is from 9:00 am-3:00 pm. We ask that you commit to attending all 7 sessions and the retreat. We suggest a donation of \$5.00 per session to defray costs.

Session dates are **January 23 & 30; February 6, 13, 20 & 27; & March 5**. The Retreat is **Saturday, February 22**. Please register by **January 10, 2020**. Registration forms are available at all church entrances.
